In 2019 the NSF will be offering scholarships to high school and post-high school students who reside(d) and attend(ed) high school within the boundaries of the Natomas Unified School District. We are offering multiple scholarships of \$1,000 each for current high school seniors and multiple scholarships of \$500.

Applicant Requirements:

- Reside(d) **and** attend(ed) high school within the boundaries of the Natomas Unified School District;
- 50 hours or more of volunteer/community service, and/or formal employment, and/or service to school through a formal club or organization during the last two years;
- Three (3) letters of reference from any of the following: counselor, teacher, coach, employer, volunteer leader, religious leader and/or neighbor;
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher;
- Short essay of 300-500 words describing what you learned from volunteer or employment experiences and how you think those lessons will help you in the future.

Applications are due April 12, 2019.

Decisions will be announced at each schools Senior Awards Night.

Awards can be used towards educational expenses in accredited four-year or two-year colleges or in a trade school.
